Leonard M. Ahrens, 84, Kearney, died Saturday, March 12, 2016 at his home. Leonard joined the Army in 1952, and served his country during the Korean Conflict until 1954. He moved to Kansas City where he worked for the post office. In 1960 Leonard moved to Kearney and worked various jobs in Kearney until retiring in 1982. He then was a caretaker for his mother until she passed away in 1993.
