



## Leroy O. Dady

December 1, 1919 - May 12, 2016

Leroy O. Dady, 96, of Kearney died Thursday, May 12, 2016, at Mother Hull Home. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at New Life Church. Burial will be at Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be from 4-6 p.m. today at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services, and one hour before services Wednesday at the church. Leroy was born Dec. 1, 1919, in Kearney to Burt and Mabel (Bowker) Dady. He attended school in Kearney. He joined the U.S. Army Air Corps in February 1942 and served during World War II. Leroy married Alice Larsen on Aug. 27, 1943, in Glendale, Calif. After his discharge in 1945, Leroy and Alice moved back to Kearney where he helped run Dady's Grocery with his father. He then worked for Cash-Wa Candy in Kearney. Leroy and Alice moved to Denver and managed an apartment complex before they moved back to Kearney and then retired in 1985. Leroy loved spending time with his family and grandchildren. He also enjoyed traveling, listening to music, watching westerns and college football, especially the Huskers. He came to have a strong faith in the Lord.
