He had served on the Church board, Redwing school board, and Harrison Township board. He had farmed and ranched all his life, raising cattle, hogs, and sheep, and his favorite job on the farm was building fence. He also loved attending his children and grandchildren's school and other events. Survivors include his wife Ruby, daughters Deanne (Miles) Alton of Lake Mary, FL, Donna (Ron) Harrop of Longwood, FL, Marilee (Ron) Mack of Llano, TX, sons Jerry (Kelly) Bentley of
