She earned her Master's Degree in English and taught for fifteen years in Iowa, Michigan, and Minnesota. On March 13, 1971 she married Philip Vreeland in Greeley, Colorado, and they moved to Kearney. She taught English at UN K and later worked at Horizon Design and Morris Press. She retired in 1999. She was a member of St. George Orthodox Church in Kearney.
