Lloyd W. Wintermote, 88, of Kearney, passed away peacefully September 23, 2018 at CHI Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m., September 27, 2018 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Amherst with Pastor Bill Heermann officiating. Burial will be 3:00 p.m. at the Chambers Cemetery. Visitation will be from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m., September 26, 2018 at Horner Lieske McBride and Kuhl Funeral Chapel, and prior to the service at the church. 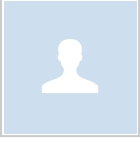

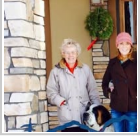
