Lois Ann Shiers, 87, formerly of Gibbon, died Friday, February 26, 2016 at Mount Carmel Home Keens Memorial in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, March 2, 2016 at the Gibbon Baptist Church with Reverend Duane Duley officiating. Burial will follow the service at Riverside Cemetery near Gibbon. Visitation will be Tuesday, March 1, 2016 from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. with the family greeting friends at the Gibbon Baptist Church, and one hour prior to the service Wednesday at the church. Lois Ann was born September 7, 1928 on the family farm southwest of Heartwell in Kearney County to George and Anna (Torske) Johansen. She graduated from Heartwell High School in 1946. In 1948 Lois and her husband moved to rural Gibbon where they farmed until retiring in the early 1980's. In 2006 they moved into Gibbon. Lois Ann loved taking care of her children and grandchildren. Her family was very important to her. She also enjoyed cooking, baking, working in her flowers, and embroidery. She made each of her children quilts. Lois Ann is survived by daughters, Dianna Frew of Gibbon, Karen Shiers of Kearney, Pamela Rasmussen and husband Steven of Gibbon; sons, Bill Shiers and wife Lynn of Gibbon, David Shiers and wife Carol of Gibbon; daughter-in-law Kindra Shiers of Gibbon; sisters, Verla Steiner of Inavale, Viola Sinsel of Minden; 18 grandchildren, 20 great grandchildren.
