Loretta E. Weiss, 67 of Kearney died Thursday, October 19, 2017 at CHI – Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Mass of Christian Burial will be 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, October 25, 2017 at St. James Catholic church, and burial will follow at the Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 24, 2017 at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services.
