Lucille, F. Gilster, 91, of Kearney, died Tuesday, December 23, 2014 at the St. John's Good Samaritan Society in Kearney.

Funeral services will be Monday, December 29, 2014 at 10:00 am at First Lutheran Church in Kearney with Pastor Meg Sander officiating. Burial will be at the Paxton Cemetery at 2:00 pm C.S.T. Visitation will be Sunday, December 28, 2014 from 4:00 to 6:00 pm at the Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services in Kearney and one hour prior to the service Monday at the church.
