She also helped with Bible School in the summer.

Lyla Dawn married Edwin "Mike" Bunn on February 14, 1946 in Phillipsburg, KS. They were married for 66 years. Lyla Dawn and Mike never had any children but enjoyed their nephews, nieces, cousins, and neighborhood children immensely. Lyla Dawn and Mike loved to camp and fish and enjoyed their pet dogs. When Lyla Dawn moved from her home in Amherst to Mother Hull Nursing Home and then Wel-Cove Assisted Living, she was like a drop of sunshine to those she met.
