Lynn served as president of the Nebraska Masonry Association and was a lifetime member of the Lions Club. He also served as a lifetime member and past president of the Nebraska Concrete and Aggregates Association, the Knights of Columbus, and the Homebuilders Association. He also volunteered his time to serve as an American Legion

Honor Guard, and security patrol for the State Patrol.

He was a member of the Prince of Peace Catholic Church and played an integral part in the design and construction of the current campus.
