Lynn E. Miller, 78 life-long resident of Kearney died on Sunday, August 12, 2018 at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney.

After graduating from college, he began farming and ranching and later worked in the appraisal and real estate field.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church and the Friendship

Sunday School Class in Kearney. He enjoyed serving his community through his involvement in Habitat for Humanity and was an active member of the Midway Amateur Radio Club and Nebraska Wing of the Civil Air Patrol. Lynn was an avid UNK Lopers and UNL Huskers fan and never met a stranger. He will be greatly missed by those who knew and loved him.

He is survived by his wife, Peggy of Kearney; daughters, Robyn (John) Forkner of Spring Hill, KS and Brooke Miller of Kearney.
