Maevis Bahde, 95, Omaha, formerly of Kearney, passed away January 6, 2021 at Brookstone Meadows in Omaha. 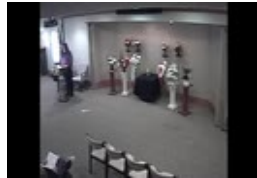
