She was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Kearney where she was a Sunday School Teacher, member of the church choir, Alter Guild and was the member of the longest chronological standing in the parish records. She was also a member of PEO chapter EG, and did volunteer work at MONA and the Good Samaritan Hospital and is a past board member of the Kearney State College Alumni Association. She belonged to the Kearney Education Association, Nebraska Education Association, National Education Association and was a

lifetime member of the P.T.A. She enjoyed traveling and kept meticulous journals of her travels. She was an avid reader but most of all enjoyed teaching.
