Marvin A. Albrecht, age 84, of Riverdale, departed his earthly life and went to his eternal home to live with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at Kearney Regional Medical Center. Memorial Services will be 10:30 a.m., October 17, 2020 at Grace Lutheran Church in Pleasanton with Pastor Dean Hanson officiating. Burial will be at 2:30 p.m., October 17, 2020 at the Armada Cemetery near Miller, Nebraska. Visitation with the family present will be from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m., October 16, 2020 at the Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services in Kearney.
