She served with the Southern Baptist Mission Board in Appalachia and taught with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in San Juan Pueblo, New Mexico. Mary Lou taught in public schools in Colorado and Nebraska. She was a reading clinician at Northern Colorado University and an instructor of several classes at the University of Nebraska – Kearney. She served as director of staff development with Education Service Unit 10 for several years. During her career in education, Mary Lou belonged to several honor societies and professional organizations. She frequently served as an officer on the

local, state, regional and national levels. She received numerous awards, especially for innovative programs in education. Mary Lou was an avid reader and especially enjoyed music and all of the arts. She cherished her home, flower gardens and animal friends. She was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Kearney.

Mary Lou is survived by her Husband, John Toker of Kearney; and many friends.
