Marylin J. Trampe, 91, of Amherst, passed away July 17, 2024 at Wel-Life Assisted Living in Kearney. Funeral Services will be 10:30 am, July 23, 2024 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Amherst with Pastor Nicholas Whitney officiating. Burial will follow at Immanuel Cemetery. Visitation will be from 5:00 to 7:00 pm, July 22, 2024 at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services and one hour prior to the service at the church. many years. She also liked reading, sewing, gardening, and playing cards with friends.
