Maurice "Red" A. Carr, age 87, of Kearney died Tuesday, October 4, 2011 at the Mother Hull Home.

Funeral services will be Monday, October 10, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. at the Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral Home with Pastor Dean Pofahl officiating. (Allen) Carr. He was raised on the farm and attended school in Allen, graduating from high school in 1941. He entered the service on May 27, 1944 and served in the U.S. Army infantry until his discharge on June 16, 1946. Following his discharge, Red returned to Allen and married to Norma G. Ellis on December 28, 1947. They lived in Allen where Red and Norma started the Red Carr farm implement dealership, moving to Wayne in 1971. They owned the dealership until they retired in 1989. He was a member of the American Legion and the V.F.W. Posts in Allen.
