Maxine Adele Thatcher, 95, Kearney, died Saturday, July 15, 2017 at the Mother Hull Home. Funeral services will be 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at First United Methodist Church in Kearney with Pastor Alan Davis officiating. Burial will be at 2:00 p.m., at the Riverside Cemetery near Gibbon. Visitation will be from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral Home and one hour prior to the service Wednesday at the church. Memorials are suggested to the family to be designated later.

Maxine was born January 19, 1922 in a farmhouse north of Loup City, Nebraska to Fred and Coral (Daddow) Zwink. At the age of 10, the Zwink family moved to a farm south of Gibbon, where she attended a one-room country school. She graduated from Gibbon High School in 1938 at the age of 16. Maxine married James Paul Thatcher December 20, 1940 in Shelton. They lived in the Gibbon area before moving west of Kearney in 1949 and then into town in 1964. After Jim passed away in 1988, she was instrumental in the development of Grand view Estates and was the first person to move there in 1994. She was a member of Midway Kensington Club and the First United Methodist Church. Maxine enjoyed being with her family and visiting with her many friends. As well as reading, playing cards and games, working on puzzles, and making greeting cards.

Maxine is survived by her sons, Fredrick Thatcher and his wife Julie of

Overland Park, KS, Lindley Thatcher and his wife Judy of Kearney; daughter Jeanne Bogner and her husband Jim of Kearney; grandchildren, Mark Thatcher, Jill Champlin, Kory Thatcher, Koby Thatcher, Kully Thatcher, Joni Fleck, and Jeff Bogner; fourteen great grandchildren; and sister in law Winona Zwink.

Maxine was preceded in death by her husband, three brothers, and two sisters.
