Mike D. Brimlow, 70, of Kearney, died, July 1, 2021, at his home. Memorial services will be 3:00 pm, July 22 2021, at the Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral Chapel with Andrea Wall officiating. Military rites will be provided by the Nebraska National Guard Funeral Honors Team, Kearney American Legion Post #52, and Kearney V.F.W. Post #759. Mike was born January 17, 1951, in Enterprise, Alabama. He was the only child born to Robert and Myrtle (Wall) Brimlow. He graduated from Lexington High School 1969. He attended Kearney State College from 1972-1977, where he lettered in football all four years as an offensive lineman.

He entered the Army in 1971 serving 2 years of active duty in Germany and state side. Mike was a member of the Army Reserves until his Honorable Discharge in 1977. He worked at Eaton Corporation in Kearney for his entire working life.

Mike was an avid softball player in his years after his football career at K.S.C. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and golfing for many years until his health issues curtailed these activities. In his retirement years, you could catch Mike keeping his home in pristine condition. He always had time for friends and his K.S.C. family.

Mike is survived by many cousins living in Nebraska, Colorado, Alabama, Kansas, Arkansas, and Florida.

Mike was preceded in death by his parents.

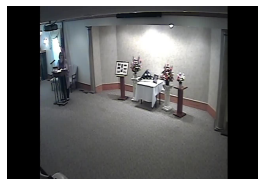

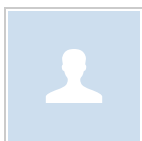
