Milda M. Markus, age 88, of Kearney, died Thursday, June 10, 2010 at the Good Samaritan Hospital shortly after being admitted. She graduated from Longfellow High School in Kearney in 1939. After attending Nebraska State Teachers College at Kearney for one year, she taught in rural Buffalo Co. School for three years. On June 14, 1943, she married Robert Markus, in Kearney. The couple lived on their farm northeast of Kearney. As a farm wife she assisted with farm chores, including raising chickens, milking cows, and gardening. She was a member of the Glenwood Kensington Extension Club, a charter member of the Soil Sisters Garden Club, and a

leader for all 3 of her daughters? 4H clubs. She served as Buffalo Co. District Glenwood School Board Treasurer for many years. She was a member of St. James Catholic Church, where she was active in the Altar Society, serving as president, and later was a church funeral dinner coordinator. She was a parish representative for Kearney Church Women United. She also was a participant and leader in a Kearney Al Anon support group. After her children were grown, she worked as a sales clerk at Kaufman Wernert Department Store and then at the Meadowlark Shop until its closing. She enjoyed traveling to visit her children and grandchildren. With their children, she and Bob traveled to Europe, Hawaii, and other destinations.
