



## Miles E. Garrison

November 29, 1928 - October 24, 2020

Miles E. Garrison, 91, of Kearney, passed away Saturday, October 24, 2020 at Mt. Carmel Home and Rehabilitation. Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m., October 28, 2020 at the Kearney E-Free Church with Pastor John Fowler and Pastor Brian Klein officiating. Burial will follow the service at Kearney Cemetery. Masks are requested to be worn by those attending the service. Memorials are suggested to the Kearney E-Free Church. No visitation is planned.

Miles was born November 29, 1928 in rural Lynn County, Texas to Miles E. and Iva J. (Greenway) Garrison. He grew up in Texas and graduated from Lubbock High School and attended Texas Tech. University.

Miles joined the Army in November of 1953 and served during the Korean Conflict.

Miles married Lois Husak on January 16, 1954 in Lubbock. They moved to Columbus, Nebraska later that year. He worked construction building houses. They moved to Kearney in 1963 and continued to work in construction. In 1966 Miles started Garrison Custom Cabinets in Kearney. He enjoyed building cabinets and remodeling homes for many years in the Kearney area.

Miles is survived by his wife Lois Garrison of Kearney; daughter, Teri and Paul Wenz of Lincoln, NE; brother, Truitt and Joyce Garrison of Granbury, TX; sister Margaret Fears of Sun City, AZ; grandson William and Melanie Wenz.

Miles was preceded in death by his son, Mark Garrison, six brothers, and one sister.
