On December 26, 1970 he married Joan Lockhart in Loomis, NE. The couple continued to farm and ranch northeast of Miller.

He attended Grandview Immanuel Missionary Church his entire life and also served as treasurer. He was a lifetime member of the Miller American Legion Post #351, Kearney V.F.W. Post #759 and the Disabled American Veterans. He is past treasurer of the Miller Alumni Association and past member and secretary of the Red Wing School Board.

Surviving relatives include his wife of Miller, daughter; Lorraine and husband Barry Hiebner of Hampton, NE, grandson; David Hiebner of Hampton, NE, sisters; Shirley McCullough and husband Alfred of Broken Bow, NE, Susan Underhill of Riverdale, NE, Sarah Graham of Miller, NE and sister in law; Ruth Day of Miller, NE.
