She graduated from Woodbine High School in 1936 then attended Northwestern Bible and Missionary Training School in Minneapolis, MN, where she graduated in 1941. She then attended Northwestern Seminary, then Tabor College in Hillsboro, KS and then graduated from Kearney State College in 1967 at the age of 49.

On March 18, 1944, she married John E. Hooe near Junction City, KS.

Following graduation from KSC, she taught school at Denman and Shelton, and worked at the Kearney State College library until retiring in 1980. She and her husband served churches in Lebo, Wellsville and Fort Scott, Kansas, Lincoln, Gibbon, Sumner, Fairhaven and Juniata, Nebraska. Following their formal retirement, they served in interim ministry in eight additional communities.

As a pastor's wife, she served as secretary, Sunday school teacher, VBS leader, pianist, choir director, confidant and more. She will be remembered for her deep faith, positive attitude, sweet disposition and spirit of gratitude.

Survivors include her brother, Dr. Robert Brenner, Clovis, CA; sister, Kathryn (Don) Younkin, Manhattan, KS; sons, John R.
