



## Richard L. 'Dick' Swett

November 18, 1932 - May 2, 2017

Richard "Dick" Swett, 84, of Kearney, died Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at Good Samaritan Society St. Luke's in Kearney. Memorial service will be held 10:30 a.m., Monday, May 8, 2017, at First Presbyterian Church with Pastor Stephen Price-Gibson officiating. Burial will be 2:30 p.m., at the Ord City Cemetery in Ord, Nebraska with Military Rites. Dick was born November 18, 1932 in Ainsworth, Nebraska to Erman and Pauline (Wright) Swett. He graduated from Wood Lake High School in 1951. He then enlisted in the Air Force, where he earned the rank of Staff Sergeant and served his country for four years. Dick then earned his teaching certificate from Kearney State College in 1959. Dick taught and coached in Superior, Nebraska and Malvern, Iowa before moving back to Kearney in 1964 to teach. He married Sharon Cetak on August 16, 1969 in Ord, Nebraska. Dick enjoyed hunting, fishing, historical biographies, and gardening. He was extremely proud of his vegetable garden. He had a lifelong love affair with all things Husker, where he was a longtime football season ticket holder. After retiring from teaching Dick and Sharon enjoyed traveling throughout the United States and Europe. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, 50 year member of the American Legion, N.E.A., N.S.E.A., and an Admiral in the Great Navy of the State of Nebraska. Dick is survived by his wife Sharon of Kearney; son, Tim Swett and his wife Lori of Rapid City, SD; daughter, Nancy Bullis and her husband Kevin of Elwood, NE; brother, Don Swett and his wife Sharon of Leadville, CO; sisters-in-law, Shirley Bundy of Grand Island, NE, Sheila Ramsey of Ord, NE; 6 grandchildren, 5 great grandchildren; nieces and nephews. Dick was preceded in death by his parents.
