



## Robert M. "Bob" Olmsted

January 30, 1931 - December 25, 2017

Robert "Bob" M. Olmsted, 86, of Kearney died Monday, December 25, 2017 at Mt. Carmel Home and Rehabilitation Center in Kearney.

Funeral services will be Friday, December 29, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. at Faith United Methodist Church in Kearney. Rev. Robert Perry will officiate and burial will be at Riverside Cemetery in Gibbon. Military Rites at the grave will be provided by the Kearney American Legion Post #52, Kearney V.F.W. Post #759 and the Nebraska National Guard Military Honors Team. Visitation is planned Thursday from 4:00 – 6:00 at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Service in Kearney or prior to services Friday at the church. He was a veteran of the Korean War serving in the U.S. Army from January 2, 1952 to December 7, 1953. After his service he returned to Kearney and established Olmsted Construction where he did masonry and construction

work. He later worked at Kearney State College and then the University Of Nebraska at Kearney as a Maintenance Mechanic until retiring.

He was a member of the Faith United Methodist Church, V.F.W. Post #759 and American Legion Post #52 both of Kearney.

Surviving relatives include his wife Corinne of Kearney; daughters, Kathy Habben and husband Jon of Nebraska City, Karen Olmsted and Robert Sinsel of Alma and Bobbi Runge and husband David of Kearney; 7 grandchildren; 11 great grandchildren; brothers, Richard Olmsted and wife Carol of Winston, OR and Guy Olmsted, Jr. and wife Marilyn of Sacramento, CA; sisters, Virginia Bradshaw and husband William, and Wilma Johnston and husband John both of Ft.
