Private burial services will precede services at the Kearney Cemetery. There will be no visitation. After high school he attended Kearney State College and the University of Wyoming in Laramie. He served in the National Guard from 1964 through 1970. After returning to Kearney, he worked for and later purchased Nebraska Irrigation Engineering, Inc. In 1988 he began working for Broadfoot Sand and Gravel where he continued to work until his death. He was confirmed in the First Lutheran Church of Kearney in 1956 and was still a member of that congregation. On January 28, 1967 he married Candace Vaught of Wayne, NE, they have three children. Allen?s interests included cars, car races, John Deere tractors, Wyoming ranches, and the farm. On weekends you would most likely find him watching the NASCAR races on television. He loved his

family and his grandchildren. It was always fun to reminisce with him. He loved to show places in Kearney where he was working or in which he had a specific interest. Surviving relatives include his wife Candace of Kearney and their 3 children and families: Troy and wife Gwen, grandchildren Bryson and Breck of Libertyville, Illinois; Tyler and wife Brandee, granddaughter Kealy of Kearney and Anne of Omaha, NE.
