Together they made their home on his parent's family farm west of Amherst. In this union they had 2 children – Steve and Bart. On the farm they raised crops, cattle, hogs and even ran a dairy. Rod also worked at Eaton during this time retiring after 30

years of service. Retirement did not slow Rod down and he opened The Gun Barn. Through this venture he entertained numerous customers from all around. This brought him immense joy and created the most wonderful friends. Rod had many visitors during business hours and after. He never knew a stranger.

Rod and Rhonda had many adventures together throughout nearly 55 years together. Left to cherish his memory is his wife Rhonda of Amherst, sons Steve (Jolynn) of Hastings, Ne and Bart of Burns, Wy; his grandchildren Dayne and Marilyn Kenzie and his trusty dog family Toby and Hank.
