Scott A. Bennett, 57, of Kearney, passed away, October 31, 2019 at C.H.I. Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:30 am, November 5, 2019 at First United Methodist Church with Rev. Alan Davis officiating. Burial will follow at the Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be from 5:30 to 7:30 pm, November 4, 2019 at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral Home and one hour prior to the service at the church. Scott was born July 25, 1962 in Kearney to Walter and Marla (Bailey) Bennett. He graduated from Gibbon High School in 1980. He attended Kearney State College, and then became certified as a dental technician.
