She then moved to Kearney, NE where she worked various full-time and part-time jobs often at the same time.

Sherry was a part of Rural Urban Youth for several years, bringing rural youth together for square dancing, volleyball, educational tours and various conferences. Lifetime friendships were made through this outreach in rural Nebraska.

Her hobbies were reading, music, and crafts of all kinds, which she loved to give away to others. She also helped with Vacation Bible School and Teen Bible Quizzing meets at the Nazarene Church. Sherry loved playing games that required logic and strategy, jig saw puzzles, word puzzles, and categorizing all her items in her house.
