He served in the United States Coast Guard from 1954 – 1958. On September 30, 1957 he married Shirley (Jeannie) Shada in Elkton, MD. The couple moved to Gering and Stan worked for the United States Postal Service from 1958 until retiring in 1990. They moved to Kearney in 2014. Stan was a member of St. George Orthodox Church in Kearney. He was a member of the Gering Volunteer Fire Department for 23 years and served as Assistant Chief. He is also a past member and Adjutant General of Gering American Legion Post #36 and also past member of the Gering Eagles and Moose Lodges.

Stan enjoyed spending time at the ball park coaching Little League and Babe Ruth League baseball. He also enjoyed camping, fishing and hunting trips with his family.
