



## Theodore R. Scholl

January 1, 1931 - August 22, 2011

Theodore R "Ted" Scholl, age 80, of Kearney, died Monday, August 22, 2011 at the Good Samaritan Hospital. Mass of Christian burial will be Thursday, August 25, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. at the St. James Catholic Church. Father Joe Hannappel will officiate. Burial will be at the St. Ann's Catholic Cemetery near Lexington at 2:00 p.m. A rosary service will be Wednesday, August 24, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at the church. Visitation will be Wednesday for one hour prior to the Rosary Service and one hour prior to the service on Thursday at the Church. He lived in Colorado until the age of 8. The family moved to Eustis, Nebraska in 1939. He graduated from Eustis High School in 1948. He worked in Holdrege for 2 years, and then returned to Eustis where he worked on a farm and for Tri County. He was drafted into the Army in January of 1952. After basic training he was stationed in Korea for 9 months. He was discharged in October 1953. He returned to Eustis and worked for Grabenstein Service Station. Ted married Veronica J. Fagot on June 27, 1955 at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Lexington, NE. In 1954 he moved to Kearney and worked Kaufmann and Wernert and Hellman's Ready to Wear until 1983. He then worked at the Moorman Feed Company until retiring in 1992. He was a member of the

Cosmopolitan Club, Kearney Elks Club, and Knights of Columbus. He was a member of St. James Catholic Church.
