Tom E. Russell, 83, of Kearney, died Monday, February 4, 2013 at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Services will be Monday, February 11, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. at Faith United Methodist Church. He served on the "Grand Canyon" as radio operator for 4 years. He married Virginia M. Rowley in Curtis, NE on January 1, 1953. The couple resided in Curtis until 1958 when they moved to Kearney. Tom enjoyed a career with the Nebraska Public Power Company first as a High Voltage Lineman and later as a dispatcher. He retired from the power company in 1989. He was a member of the Faith United Methodist church in Kearney and also the Kearney V.F.W. where he served on the funeral honors team for over

25 years. He was also an active member of the Kearney IOOF Lodge and served as Secretary. He later served as Grand Patriarch of the Grand Encampment from 1996 1997. Tom enjoyed fishing, pheasant hunting, camping and football. He especially enjoyed spending time with his family.
