She later moved to Grand Island where she experienced the 1980 tornadoes. In Grand Island she worked for St. Francis hospital until she met Bob through a dating club magazine. They married on October 20, 1984 and moved to Redding, CT. In 1987 they bought a farm north of Riverdale, NE. Wanda worked at Head Start and later became a foster parent until they adopted Everett and Grant in 1993. In 1996 she went to work at Morris Press in Kearney and continued there until 2009 when they moved to Florida to retire.
