Warren E. Lammers, age 90, of Kearney, died February 8, 2011 at Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be Monday at 10:30 a.m. at First Lutheran Church in Kearney. Rev. He was a veteran of WWII, serving in the U.S. Navy from 1943 ? 1946. On October 4, 1946 he married Rosella Jochem in Kearney. Warren and Rosella made their home in Paxton, NE where they farmed for a number of years. Warren was forced to change careers due to a back injury. He worked in sales and also took correspondence courses in accounting. Warren then worked as a bookkeeper for various companies around Kearney. He started working for Baldwin Manufacturing as an accountant in 1957. He later retired from Baldwin in 1982 as a Vice President. He was a member of the First Lutheran Church in

Kearney and also the V.F.W. Post #759 and the Kearney Elks Lodge #984. Warren enjoyed his time as a farmer and continued to collect toy and antique tractors, especially John Deere.
