



## Wayne E. Fyfe

Wayne E. Fyfe, age 77, of Kearney died Saturday, January 25, 2014 at Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Memorial services will be Wednesday, January 29, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. at First United Methodist Church in Kearney. Rev. Gary Main will officiate and burial will follow at Kearney Cemetery. Subsequent to his schooling, Wayne was united in marriage to Marilyn (Morton) Fyfe, and the couple's union was blessed with four children. Wayne made a living as a police officer and facility supervisor at Monroe Automotive. In later years, he also enjoyed several positions in sales where his gift for talking and love for people made him quite successful.

His hobbies were gardening, bird watching, fishing, hunting, camping, and following the sporting events of his children and grandchildren. Wayne's greatest sense of pride was obvious when he spoke about his grandchildren, Josh, Luke, and Carlie, and their

accomplishments with the Hastings College Broncos and University of Nebraska Cornhuskers.

Wayne was preceded in death by his grandparents, parents, ex-wife Marilyn, brother Doyle Fyfe, sister Joyce Fritz, and brother-in-law Ted Fritz.
