He was also a member of Rob Morris Masonic Lodge #46, Tehama Temple Shrine and the Kearney Elks Lodge #984. He is a past president of the Farm Bureau and had served on boards for the Odessa Township, Kearney Rural Fire District #1 and the Kearney Coop. Wayne was involved with 4 H and the Buffalo county fair and also did volunteer work at the Good Samaritan Hospital for many years. He received the Kearney Hub Freedom Award for Agriculture and the Kearney Area Chamber of Commerce Leadership Award in 1993.
